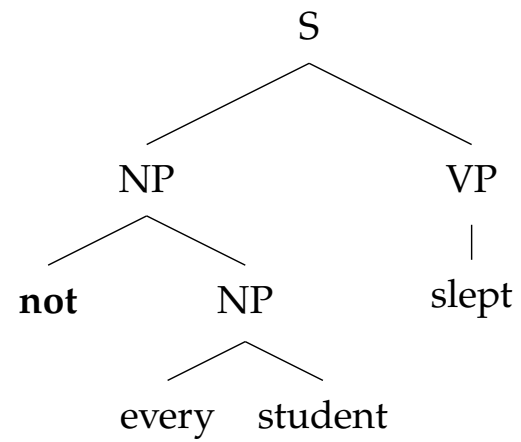

For the sentences below, identify the tense and aspect. Based on the Reichenbachian theory of tense and aspect relations (see (16) and (17) from handout), what do we predict for the relationships between UT, TT, and ET below? Does this agree with our intuitions?

- (1) After he bought some yarn, Henrison **knitted** a sweater at home.
- (2) When yarn became illegal, Henrison **was knitting** a sweater at home.
- (3) Before winter descended upon Singapore, Henrison **had knit** a sweater.
- (4) After yarn was made illegal, Henrison **has bought** yarn (illegally).
- (5) Today, yarn **has been** illegal for one month.
